GLOBAL ALUMNI CRISIS SUPPORT INITIATIVE

Introduction


The Global Alumni Crisis Support Initiative is a unique initiative by SLSP that seeks to aid students and alumni of the college in times of crisis such as medical, financial, and international emergencies, as well as offering professional support and assistance in higher education. The concept of the Crisis Support Initiative emerged during the Alumni Meet of 2021, wherein the Alumni and the faculty part of the Meet discussed the feasibility and requirement of such an initiative.

CRISIS SUPPORT CABINET

The initiative is piloted and guided by the Crisis Support Cabinet. The Cabinet provides advice and facilitates effective and transparent cross-group communication. The Cabinet's primary job is to oversee the operation of the entire initiative and advise and guide the committee for its improvement.

CRISIS SUPPORT GROUPS

The initiative is designed to enable efficient communication and comprises of two groups- the Core Group and the Regional Groups- operating at different levels, to ensure smooth and efficient communications. These groups are channelized for both inter and intra-regional crisis management as indicated below:



The regional groups provide alumni a way to express their issues through WhatsApp groups, distinctively classified and sub-classified for those living in India and abroad, consisting of 100–150 alumni each and 3-5 members as the Points of Contact (PoC). These POCs serve as a conduit between the regional groups and the crisis management committee. For Alumni living abroad, the regional groups have been categorized into the following regions: Americas, Europe, Middle East & Africa, Oceania & Asia. For the alumni living in India, the groups have been created on a zonal basis, viz. North, South, East and West.

The second category, the Core Group has been created to tackle issues beyond the capacity of regional groups. Their key role is to facilitate inter-group communication between the regional groups, thus expanding the scope of crisis management beyond the regional groups, thus facilitating a larger base of alumni assistance. It consists of the Points of Contacts from all the regional groups, the Invitees, the advisors, the convenor and co convenors and finally the Faculty in-charges of the Alumni Committee.

PROCEDURE OF RESOLUTION

The procedure of resolution commences when the alumni facing an issue communicates it either to the volunteer or the PoC in their regional group. The PoC or volunteer, once informed of the crisis, will then initiate the process of resolution by seeking assistance from the group members. They will not only communicate the crisis to the members, but will also urge them to assist the member in need. Further, they will also assist in coordinating the response by the members.

If the issue present extends beyond the scope of the regional group or the regional group fails to resolve the issue by themselves, the PoC will bring the issue to the notice of the Core Group through which a proper channel for resolution can be established. Therein, the PoCs of other groups will communicate the issue to their own regional groups, thus allowing for the resolution of the issue at by a larger base of alumni.


REVIEW AND FEEDBACK

A review process will also be undertaken to ensure that the groups are functioning properly, and alumni are able to receive prompt aid. Feedback from the alumni about the efficacy and effectiveness of the initiative has been collected and viable suggestions have been implemented.
